TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Award is determined by a Merit Selection process with Criteria assessed by a Committee comprising P&Cs Qld staff, QCPCA Board Directors and a representative of the Promotional Partner for the Award.
2. Entry is open to State School P&C Associations who are affiliated, financial members of P&Cs Qld only.
3. The Award will be made at the discretion of QCPCA.
4. In all, nine (9) Awards may be made. Eight (8) finalists for the State Award, one from each of the QCPCA Areas will each receive the Award of Area P&C of the Year, and the P&C of the Year Award for Queensland will be judged from those finalists. The finalists will be contacted by P&Cs Qld to request attendance at the Awards Ceremony.
5. The Awardees will receive the following:
 - P&C of the Year Award for Queensland – an amount of \$4000 to be paid directly by cheque to the winning P&C Association, and citation.
 - eight (8) Area P&C of the Year Awards for each of the eight areas an amount of \$1000 to be paid directly by cheque to the winning P&C Association, and citation.No funds will be distributed to individuals or schools.
6. The Awards Ceremony will be held at the QCPCA Conference in Brisbane, 8 September 2018.
7. To enter, P&Cs must
 - accept the Terms and Conditions
 - complete a P&C of the Year Award Nomination Form which addresses the P&C of the Year Award Selection Criteria
 - in addition, you are required to submit a presentation demonstrating your P&C's focus on excellence
8. All video entries must comply with the DEPT of Education Social Media Policy available on the P&Cs Qld 'Info Place'.
9. P&C entrants in the competition may enter once only per year.
10. Past Awardees may apply annually.
11. QCPCA will require finalists to provide:
 - sign-off and written comment by the Principal of the P&C's school
 - sign-off by a member of the P&C's Executive committee
 - evidence of permissions/licence for the use of music in the video component
 - proof of financial compliance may be requested

In the event that a finalist cannot provide evidence of the above, the entry may be rejected by the judging panel.

12. QCPCA reserves the right to disqualify any entry which, in the opinion of QCPCA,
- includes objectionable content, profanity, or insulting, inflammatory or defamatory statements
 - has tampered with the entry process and is not in accordance with these terms and conditions of entry
 - has engaged in conduct in entering the promotion which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Award.

13. While adopting flexible processes, QCPCA reserves the right not to accept responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries including those delayed in the posting of comments, for any reason.

14. The winner of a P&C of the Year Award will permit any of its information including photographs and video, and those taken by QCPCA, to be used by QCPCA and the Awards Sponsor for advertising, marketing and media use, without charge.
