

Simple steps to participate in the Queensland container refund scheme



Find your CRS champion

All successful fundraising activities are coordinated by a champion who drives the activity and inspires others to volunteer. It is important to have a champion willing to coordinate this activity before participating in the CRS.



Register your P&C for a unique Scheme ID

Register your P&C for a Scheme ID on the Containers for Change website. Use our "How to" guide on the P&Cs Qld CRS website if you need help with this step. It may take up to two weeks for Containers for Change to verify your Scheme ID.



Set a fundraising goal

Set a fundraising goal, and an activity or purpose that the funds will be used for. Ensure that all funds raised from the CRS go towards your nominated activity/purpose.



Promote your unique Scheme ID to the school community

Once your Scheme ID has been verified by Containers for Change, you can promote it to your school community. Use Facebook and the school newsletter, and put up posters around the school.



Education

Educate your school community about the importance of participating in the CRS: recycling reduces litter in our waterways and oceans. Talk to the students on parade/assembly about which containers are eligible and how the funds generated will help the school. Maybe your school leaders could even perform a skit about the CRS!



Off-site donations

Encourage your school community to use the P&C's Scheme ID to donate the refund from their containers to the P&C when they take containers to their local depot, reverse vending machine or bag drop.
